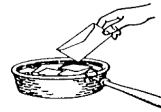

SAINT WILLIAM COMMUNITY PROJECT NEEDS VOLUNTEERS

The Saint William Community Project is a parish wide event taking place on April 14th that seeks to bring parishioners together to serve those in need. The project is founded upon the vision of our pastor, Fr. Dean, to move from maintenance to mission. The goal of the project is to serve our pastor's vision by drawing parishioners together from our community and reaching out to people in the Round Rock community. In the future, we hope to grow the scope of the project and serve more people in partnership with other Round Rock organizations. By participating in the project you will have the opportunity to grow as stewards of the gifts God has entrusted to you and to help enrich the lives of your neighbors. This is the first year the project will take place and we need your help to make it a success.

Parishioners who volunteer will be organized into teams and assigned to a site to do work for a family or person in need. The work necessary will depend on the site and may include yard work, home cleaning, and minor construction projects. Each site will be overseen by a volunteer site leader. The project will begin at St. William Parish with a commencement prayer and a blessing from a priest. We will then head out to our respective sites, work for the day, and break for lunch with those we are serving. At the end of the day we will return to St. William for the 5:00 pm Vigil Mass.

What we need from Volunteers:

We need you to volunteer to be a part of the project. You should be ready and willing to work in whatever way necessary at each site. We also need site leaders who will be responsible for keeping track of the work needed at their assigned sites, directing volunteers in that work, organizing various odds and ends, and ensuring the proper tools are available to do the work. Sign-ups will be held after Masses the first two Weekends in February.
